Each of the four grade levels will be judged separately. Various prizes will be awarded at different levels of judging. The national grand prize is \$1.000, \$500 and \$250 for first through third place respectively. The Middleboro MA Lodge #1274's Americanism Committee will judge all submitted entries, and award students locally, before submitting our finalists' essays to the district and national contest.

Please encourage all your 5<sup>th</sup> through 8th grade students to write and submit their essays to our lodge by December 15, 2024.
